NORTH CENTRAL TRIAL GARDEN

The North Central Trial Garden did see another year despite a policy change last year for the U of MN Landscape Arboretum that affected recruitment of volunteers for Trial Garden maintenance and possibly its' existence. The garden was planted May 25th and flourished into the best garden we've had in many years. All but one of 29 entries grew and were judged. Our co-directors have been moving into a fertilizer phase for the garden with resulting growth and bloom surpassing any we've ever seen here before. An interesting result of this was the lack of tuber growth. Historically the garden has produced humungous tubers. The buffers, however, were not fertilized and produced the usual huge tuber clumps. Near record amounts of rain this year meant little watering with rancid swamp water which was probably another factor working in our favor. The judges' wrap-up day was held Sept. 7th resulting in approximately 85% of the entries passing.
